The culture you create as a leader	Connect to and expand on the foundational concepts/behaviors of Give and Take/Servant Leadership via the sharing of personal experiences.
Service and the social impact	Demonstrate through personal experience how leaders can leverage their time and expertise to forward a social mission; connect to the foundational Leadership Capabilities.
Inspiring to achieve a common goal	To provide personal examples and insights into service and social impact to communities served.
Commitment to community	Showcase how you, as a leader, can instill a community commitment in your teams.
Remaining action oriented	Develop the ability to leverage inner drive to build and grow things, connecting with others throughout the process. Target and achieve results; full of energy and willing to take a hands-on approach, moves quickly from planning to action.
Defining a compelling vision	Discuss developing and sharing a clear and optimistic vision for the future of the organization. Inspire and motivate others to consider future possibilities and the wider purpose of the organization.
